

The Departments with the General Fund provide for a variety of services. The following briefly describes the function of each department:

Legislative/Administration: Provides for a portion of the costs for the Mayor, Council and City Administrator wages/salaries and operations.

Finance/Administration: Direct costs for the costs associated with the treasurer functions such as banking fees and audit costs.

Grants: Provides services related to grant management and research.

Legal: Legal services for the city such as assistance with ordinances/resolutions, claims management and preparation of legal documents.

Civil Service: Provides testing service for law enforcement personnel and acts as a hearing board for personnel issues.

Other Governmental Services: Accounts for those general costs such as building maintenance, operational supplies, communications and legal notices that are not associated with any one department.

Law Enforcement: General police services and operational costs for law enforcement personnel.

Law Enforcement Legal: Those functions associated with defense and prosecuting attorneys, court filing fees and jail fees.

Emergency Services: Training costs and fees associated with the Department of Emergency Management.

Code Enforcement: Animal control and other enforcement of municipal codes.

Planning and Development: Responsible for land use issues, GMA compliance, long range planning and land use code amendments.

Building and Community Development: Issues building permits, provides code enforcement and flood mitigation, management and planning.

Public Health: City share of county wide health costs.

Library: Provides library services for the City through the Sno Isle System.

Parks: General operational and maintenance costs for the city parks.
