



## Planning Department Notice of Application of Land Use Action(s)

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**PROJECT NAME:** Daisy Meadows - Rezone and Subdivision

**FILE NUMBER:** PP19-001

**DESCRIPTION:** The applicant, Acme Homes, has applied for a rezone and preliminary plat approval for a 70-lot single family development on 14.11 acres (approximately 614,589 square feet). The site currently has an existing single-family residence which will be removed. The project is split zoned Low Density and Moderate Density Residential and the applicant has submitted a request to rezone the Low Density Residential portion to Moderate Density Residential. The comprehensive plan designation is also split between Low/Moderate Density and Moderate Density.

**LOCATION:** The site is located at 31931 135<sup>th</sup> Street, Sultan WA 98294, Snohomish County tax parcel Nos. 28083200100200, 28083200103400, and 28083200101000; Township 28, Range 08, Section 32, Willamette Meridian (W.M.).

**APPROVALS REQUIRED (to the extent known):** Rezone, preliminary subdivision, site civil review/approval and any additional permits which are contained in the current application and required by Title 19.

**APPLICATION PROCESS:** A preliminary plat is a Level III application per City of Sultan Municipal Code (SMC) Chapters 19.06, 19.08 and 19.26. Level III preliminary plats receive development authorization by the director when it is determined by the hearing examiner that the proposal complies with the provisions of the code and the comprehensive plan.

**STUDIES REQUIRED (to the extent known):** Geo Technical Report, Stormwater Report, Targeted Drainage Report and Wetland Report. **DATE OF NOTICE OF APPLICATION (NOA):** March 18, 2019

**COMMENT PERIOD:** There is a 14-day public comment period per SMC Chapter 19.34. Submit written comments on or before **5 p.m., April 1, 2019**. Comments should address completeness of the application, quality or quantity of information presented, and the project's conformance to applicable plans or code.

**REQUEST FOR SPECIAL NOTICE:** A person may request to be provided special notice of a particular application process filed under the provisions of this title by one of the following methods:

1. Filing a no-cost form provided by the City for the purposes of requesting a special notice.
2. Providing by letter or email a request for special notice which clearly states: a) The requester's name and contact information; b) The specific application of interest in the request.

- You may become a party of record for a project by: 1) submitting original written comments and request to become a party of record to the City Planning Department prior to the hearing; 2) testifying at the hearing; or 3) entering your name on a sign up register at the hearing. NOTE: Only persons who submit written or oral testimony to the permit issuing authority may appeal the decision.
