**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SULTAN, WASHINGTON,  
DESIGNATING AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE TO  
OBTAIN STATE AND FEDERAL DISASTER ASSISTANCE  
FUNDS.**

WHEREAS, In February 2020, the City of Sultan experienced a severe storm causing flooding, landslides, and damage to numerous public and private facilities; and

WHEREAS, On April 23rd, 2020, the U.S. President declared this event to be a major disaster, opening the door for federal reimbursement funds to repair the damaged property;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SULTAN, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Nate Morgan, Public Works Director is hereby designated the authorized representative and Will Ibershof, City Administrator is designated the alternate for and in behalf of the City of Sultan, a public agency established under the laws of the state of Washington.

Section 2. The purpose of this designation as the authorized representative is to obtain federal and/or state emergency or disaster assistance funds. These representatives are authorized on behalf of the City of Sultan to execute all contracts, certify completion of projects, request payments, and prepare all required documentation for funding requirements.
