SUBJECT: Comprehensive Plan Update: Chapter 9 Capital Facilities

DESCRIPTION: The City of Sultan is updating Chapter 9 (Capital Facilities) of their Comprehensive Plan. Proposed changes are meant to correct unintentional errors from last year's update as well as updating capital project cost estimates based on recent bids.

PUBLIC HEARING: The City of Sultan has re-scheduled the Public Hearing before the Planning Board to provide enough advance notice to meet the OPMA posting requirements. The new Public Hearing will be held at the Planning Board's regular meeting on **August 16, 2022 at 7:00PM**. Planning Board meetings are held in person at City Hall but the public may also attend virtually through the zoom platform.
